

PROVECTA®

Hybrid insecticides efficacy enhancer with a physical mode of action.

It is recommended to be used for a treatment of resistant pest populations in hardly accessible locations (e.g. bed bugs).

Modifies the exposure profile of the insects enhancing the bioavailability of the active ingredient(s).

Provides an even deposition of the active ingredient on the treated surface.

Dosage

Provecta should be used in 0,1 % (1ml/1l) dose, mixed with an insecticide spray solution prepared in advance.

Instructions for use

Prepare an insecticide working solution. Add a proper dose of Provecta. Shake well.

Special recommendations

Provecta . Special care should be taken while using Provects mixture on the surface susceptible to damage/stains e.g. mattresses.

Trial treatment is recommended before proper treatment.

Ingredients

- 60 % polymeric silicone compounds

CAUTION
